Job Title: Level I Medical Volunteer

Purpose: To support the mission of the ambulance service by providing assistance during special events, third rides, and community engagement and education.

Key Responsibilities:

- · Work on a response team to locate patients and assist as directed
- Participate in 3rd Rides
- Support the work of licensed individuals as directed
- Assist with cleaning and resupply as necessary
- Promote a positive image of the organization in the communities we serve
- Participate in community education and events
- Other duties as assigned

Reports to: On Duty Supervisor and Community Relations Coordinator

Length of Appointment: Volunteers will remain in their positions unless:

- · Volunteer is hired at EHP
- · Volunteer takes on another volunteer role
- Volunteer provides a written resignation
- Volunteer is removed from the program for other reasons

Qualifications:

- 18 years or older
- Legally authorized to work in the United States
- Satisfactory Background Check and Drug Screening Results
- Acceptable vision test results
- Volunteers must complete and pass all required training provided by ambulance service

Support: Training for this position will be provided by the ambulance service.

Dress Code: Volunteers will wear a company issued shirt with logo. Their company issued ID must be worn at all times.
